The papers of Evelyn Becker McCune (1907-2012) span the years of 1701-2009, with the bulk of the material concentrated in the middle to late 1900s. The papers consists of published work, correspondences, articles, news clippings, government reports, lecture material, student work, research papers, bibliographies, and miscellaneous items. The majority of the collection includes drafts of publications and work during her years as a professor at Diablo Valley College where she taught history and art history.
