Esther Park

- Born on October 18, 1902 in Pyongyang, North Korea.
- Arrived in Hawaii on board Mongolia with parents (Chong Soo Park) on September 26, 1904 (entered as Po Pai Pak).
- Schooling at the Mid Pacific Institute (1918-1922) and University of Hawaii (1922-1926).
- Taught at Kohala Girls School for 1 year.
- Worked at Honolulu YWCA for 19 years.
- Sent to Korea by the National Board of New York YWCA and arrived in Korean November 17, 1947 as American advisory secretary for the Korean YWCA, which was establishing during the 1920s by Dr. Helen Kim.
- Became American Citizen on April 22, 1955.
- Retired from the Korean YWCA in 1977 and returned to Honolulu.
